**PROPOSED NEW DPHHS RULE RE GENERAL MEDICAID
SERVICES, PHYSICIAN ADMINISTERED DRUGS**

**PUBLIC HEARING DATE: MARCH 25, 2008, 11 am
WRITTEN COMMENT DEADLINE: MARCH 27, 2008**

**If you administer drugs (i.e. injectibles) to your patients, this rule may affect you. The CMS is requiring states to obtain rebates on at least the top 20 multiple source physician-administered drugs with the highest dollar volume dispensed under the Medicaid program and manufactured by companies that have a signed rebate agreement with CMS. States may require reporting of the National Drug Codes (NDCs) on all physician-administered drugs for rebate purposes. If this pertains to you, you may access the proposed rule at:
